YARD INFORMATION SHEET

Spring Clean Up: We begin work MARCH 1st weather permitting. Our spring clean-up consists of raking through your entire lawn, cleaning out all beds of debris, cutting lawn if necessary, re-edging all existing beds & removing all debris from your property if compost space is not available or keeping the debris if not desired.

Lawn Maintenance: We start our weekly lawn cutting by mid April & our grass cutting will usually end by mid October.

Fall Clean Up: Begins by mid October and consists of blowing the leaves into the woods or to the street and cutting the grass as necessary. Depending on **WEATHER CONDITIONS** we are able to visit your property three or four times by the end of November or early December, this especially applies for those houses that we cut the grass toward the end of the week during the growing season, and it is charged on an hourly basis plus a fee for disposal if we have to take them away.

(Adverse weather conditions will affect the number of hours needed to complete this task, see contract for fee, it reflects amount of time spent in the past for existing customers.)

Shrub & Small Tree Trimming: Our trimming begins in July and ends in August. It consists of trimming all the shrubs and small trees as needed on your property. This service also includes weeding all your beds as needed. This service is billed at a rate of \$45.00/hr with a disposal fee to be added equivalent to the amount of debris hauled away if no compost area is available.

Mulching: We begin this service in May it is strongly suggested because it helps control weeds, retains moisture for the plant, prevents soil erosion and gives your property a manicured appearance. This service is billed at a rate of \$45.00/hr plus materials and delivery starting at \$25.00 per yard.

Weed Pre-emergent Product applied to all planting beds 2 times in addition to the one in spring clean up.

Lawn Aeration is strongly suggested in September along with over seeding to improve the turf quality.

LAWN TREATMENTS INFORMATION SHET

In March & April, We will apply **fertilizer**. This is a slow release balanced fertilizer and it will provide nutrients gradually to your lawn. **WATER AFTER APPLICATION** **YES NO**

In April & May, We will apply a **broadleaf and crabgrass control**. This application will reduce any unwanted weeds currently growing in your lawn plus it will prevent the germination of crabgrass. **DO NOT WATER AFTER APPLICATION** **YES NO**

In June, We will apply **insect control plus fertilizer**. The insecticide will control undesirable insects like chinch bug, ticks that feed on grass blades and will keep grub population under control which in return will help minimize costly lawn repairs due to insects root feeding. A balanced 100% slow release fertilizer is incorporated in this application, which will provide a gradual release of nutrients to your lawn. **WATER AFTER APPLICATION** **YES NO**

**** Watering deep not more than a couple of times per week will reduce drought stress and grass damage****

In July, We will apply a summer slow release **fertilizer and lime**. This application is using the lime to help control alkalinity of the soil and using the fertilizer to maintain the fertility thru the summer months. **WATER AFTER APPLICATION** **YES NO**

In September, We will apply an early fall **fertilizer and control any broadleaf weeds**. This slow release fertilizer will begin the rebuilding process after the stressful summer, if any heat or drought damage has occurred. The weed control will take care of any weeds that came in the summer months. **DO NOT WATER AFTER APPLICATION** **YES NO**

In October , We will apply a late fall **fertilizer**. This balance slow release fertilizer is designed to be stored in the lawn roots system to feed the turf though the winter months and have a quicker green up in the following spring. **DO NOT WATER AFTER APPLICATION** **YES NO**

Weather permitting work begins March 1st with the houses we mow Mondays and so on.

Prices may change due to cost of living or material cost. A late payment charge not to exceed 1.5% or \$5 minimum applies to any balance carried forward to next month's statement. All cost arising from collection procedures are customer's responsibility
